In Cambridge Scientific Abstracts (CSA) Indexes:

1. Select citations to save.
2. Click on Save/Print/Email.
3. Under Record Format choose Complete Record.
4. Click on Save.
5. Under the File menu, select Save As. Choose where you want to save your citations (i.e. desktop) and give your file a name. Under Save As Type select .txt, click on Save.

In EndNote:

1. Open the EndNote library where you would like the citations to go.
2. Under the File menu, choose Import.
3. Under Import Data File, select Choose File. Locate the file location of your saved citations and select the file.
4. Under Import Option, look for the index name that you did your original search. If it is not listed, choose Other Filters. Select the appropriate index filter.

Use *ArtbiblioModern (CSA)* filter.

Use *ASFA (CSA)* filter.

Use *ASFA (CSA)* filter.

Pollution Abstracts

Use *ASFA (CSA)* filter. Imperfect. May place journal page numbers in Notes field.

Sociological Abstracts

Use *Sociological Abs (CSA)* filter.

Water Resources Abstracts

Use *ASFA (CSA)* filter.

Zoological Record

Use *Zoological Record Plus (CSA)* filter. Imperfect. May input some journal names in the Notes field.
