



Importing Citations from MathSciNet (American Mathematical Society) into EndNote 5 or 6

In MathSciNet:

1. Mark citations to import by clicking the check-box next to the citation.
2. Go to the top of the page. At the drop-down box on the left side of the screen, change Reviews (HTML) to Citations (EndNote) and then click on the Retrieved Mark link.
3. From the File menu, choose Save As.
4. Choose where you want to save the citations (i.e. desktop) and give your file a name. Under Save As Type, select Text File (*.txt).

In EndNote:

1. Open the EndNote library where you would like the citations to go.
 2. Under the File menu, choose Import.
 3. Under Import Data File, select Choose File. Locate the file location of your saved citations and select the file.
 4. Under Import Option, choose Refer/BibIX.
 5. Click on Import.
