Importing from Eureka Indexes:

1. Select citations to save.
2. Click on Preferences. Under email/print/download option, select EndNote native format. Click on apply preferences.
3. Click on Print. Go to File and choose Save As.
4. Choose a location for your file (i.e. desktop). Name the file with a .txt extension. Select Text File (*.txt) under Save As Type. Click on Save.

In EndNote:

1. Open EndNote and open or create a library for your citations.
2. Go to File, choose Import.
3. Find file location under Choose File.
4. Change Import Option to "Refer/BibIX"
5. Click on Import.
