



## Importing Citations from the NLM Gateway into EndNote 5 or 6

The NLM Gateway (<http://gateway.nlm.nih.gov/gw/Cmd>) allows searches of multiple databases available from the National Library of Medicine. The current Gateway searches include references from: MEDLINE/PubMed, OLDMEDLINE, LOCATORplus, MEDLINEplus, DIRLINE, AIDS Meetings, Health Services Research Meetings, Space Life Sciences Meetings, and HSRProj.

### In NLM Gateway:

1. Run your search in the Gateway. Mark citations to save. Click on Download or Display button.
2. Change the settings as follows:  
Results From: Selected  
Details: Complete  
Format: Export  
Destination: Save to file  
Download or Send As: Text  
  
Click on Go.
3. From the File menu, select Save As.
4. Within Save Web Page box, choose the location of where to save this file (i.e. desktop). Give the file a name of your choice. Under Save As Type, select Text File (\*.txt). Click on Save.

### In EndNote:

1. Open EndNote and open (or create a new) library for these citations.
2. Go to File, choose Import.
3. Under Import Data File, select Choose File. Locate the file location of your saved citations and select the file.
4. Under Import Option, look for filter name. If it is not listed, choose Other Filters. Select the filter called Gateway (NLM).
5. Click on Import.
