



## Importing Citations from GeoRef into EndNote 5 or 6

### In GeoRef:

1. Run your search and mark citations to save.
2. Scroll down to the end of the citations display and find the Citation Manager.
3. Under Format, change to EndNote. Select the appropriate settings for Download and Content. Do not check Include Search Strategy.
4. Click on Download.
5. From the File menu, choose Save As.
6. Save the file in the location of your choice (i.e. desktop), give the file a name of your choice. Under Save As Type select Text File (\*.txt).
7. Click on Save.

### In EndNote:

1. Go to File, choose Import.
2. Under Import Date File, select Choose File. Locate the file location of your saved citations and select the file.
3. Under Import Option, select Refer/BibIX.
4. Click on Import.

NOTE: May input monographs as journal articles. Verify data in all EndNote fields.
