# CINAHL : NURSING & ALLIED HEALTH

The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL) offers a variety of resources that make it unique when compared to most other health sciences databases/article indexes. Besides coverage of more than 1600 nursing & allied health journals, CINAHL also indexes publications of the American Nurses Association, the National League for Nursing, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, chapters in healthcare books, standards of professional practice, educational software and audiovisual materials. There are more than 18,000 records with full text. Full text records include standards of practice, government publications, research instruments and patient education material.

Approximately 70 percent of CINAHL subject headings also appear in MEDLINE. CINAHL supplements these headings with 2,000+ terms designed specifically for nursing and allied health. Database coverage is from 1982 to the present.

Ovid access is provided for current faculty, staff and students. Use the **Personal Login** when connecting from home or if you want to save, as well as personalize your search results displays (**Generic** is for in-library use only and you cannot save your searches when in **Generic**). Click on the **Start Ovid** button.

### LIMITING & SPECIALIZED SUBSETS

CINAHL has several specialized limits, categories or quality filters that are available.

You can limit your search to retrieve only articles that are flagged as research studies – containing data collection, methodologies and discussion of research results.

Publication types in CINAHL run from the more usual abstracts, book chapters, clinical trials, journal articles & systematic reviews, to the more unusual – cartoons, clinical innovations, critical paths, legal cases, poetry, research instruments and websites. These represent either the type of publication indexed (journal, book, etc.), the format of the item (editorial, review, etc.) or indicate some sort of special data is available (formula, etc).

### REFERENCE LISTS

CINAHL includes bibliographic citations for selected references. You can limit your search to only those citations that have a bibliography attached. These references are located in [complete reference](#) after the abstract.
